The Committee met as required by [Code of Alabama §41-9-234](#) to elect a chair and vice chair for the following year. Ed Crowell and Gary Fuller were elected to the positions, respectively. The Committee also reviewed and approved an annual report of activity during FY 2024.

The Committee received a report by the Alabama Historical Commission on the awarding of a \$9,000 grant to the Raphael Semmes SCV Camp #2 in Mobile for the cleaning and reassembly of the interpretive base and panels on the Raphael Semmes statue. Funding originated from fees collected by the Office of the Attorney General for violation of the Alabama Memorial Preservation Act.
